



MATTHEW SHAW – NOTARY PUBLIC

Matthew Shaw was appointed a Notary Public in June 2023.

Matthew works on an appointment system only so if you wish to make an appointment, please call our office on 07 347 0079.

When attending our office for an appointment it is important to have formal identification with you ideally your passport or photo drivers licence.

If the document being notarised refers to a specific identity document, then Matthew will need to sight that document as well.

Prior to your appointment if you can email the document you need notarised to Matthew that will help in preparation for the attendance because in some cases a formal notary certificate will be required.

Some of the documents once signed by the notary will need to be sent to the Department of Internal Affairs in Wellington for authentication. Matthew Shaw Legal can assist you with this.

What is a Notary Public? – A Notary Public (sometimes called a Notary or a Public Notary) in New Zealand is a lawyer authorised by the Archbishop of Canterbury in England to officially witness signatures on legal documents, collect sworn statements, administer oaths and certify the authenticity of legal documents for use overseas.
